




## COVID-19 Receival Site Guidelines

During the 21/22 harvest, COVID-19 outbreaks could lead to grain receival sites closing or restricting operations. These guidelines are for truck drivers & grain receival site staff.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Sign in with the State Government QR code</li> <li>◆ Minimise paperwork: encourage one-way paper flow &amp; no signatures</li> <li>◆ Where possible, use an online delivery advice for NGR/Grower Card &amp; truck details and give truck drivers electronic copies of delivery dockets</li> <li>◆ Drivers verbally advise truck permit number(s) where required and do not pass permits between drivers and staff</li> <li>◆ Use antibacterial wipes on shared surfaces</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Do not share pens - truck drivers should bring their own pen, otherwise single use pens</li> <li>◆ Avoid truck passengers coming onto sites during harvest</li> <li>◆ Coffee vans or BBQs at sites are not recommended</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Follow the directions of staff on site</li> <li>◆ Socially distance, especially in truck queues</li> <li>◆ Regular handwashing and follow government advice on face masks</li> <li>◆ If unwell, stay home and get tested</li> </ul>

In addition to these steps, it is important to adhere to federal/state COVID-19 guidelines.
