During the 2020 harvest, COVID-19 outbreaks could lead to grain receival sites closing or restricting operations. These guidelines are for drivers of grower trucks and grain receival site staff.

|  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Minimise paperwork: use online systems, encourage one-way paper flow and no signatures ◆ Where requested , use a paper or online pre-delivery advice for NGR/Grower Card and truck details ◆ Do not pass truck permits between drivers and staff ◆ Use antibacterial wipes on shared surfaces |
|  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Do not share pens - truck drivers should bring their own pen, otherwise single use pens ◆ Avoid truck passengers coming onto sites during harvest ◆ Coffee vans or BBQs at sites are not recommended ◆ Use the COVID Safe App to assist with contact tracing |
|  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Follow the directions of staff on site ◆ Socially distance, especially in truck queues ◆ Regular handwashing and follow government advice on face masks ◆ If unwell, stay home and get tested |

In addition to these steps, it is important to adhere to federal/state COVID-19 guidelines.
